Description of Hot-Mix Asphalt Surface Course and Binder 2025

- A. Nunda Township Road District (N.T.R.D.) is seeking bids for Asphalt N50 (material only) which includes Surface and Binder Material.
- B. N.T.R.D. is performing all the labor and machine time associated with grinding, placing, leveling, and rolling the asphalt.
- C. N.T.R.D. will pick up the asphalt from the plant and deliver it to site.
- D. A haul differential of \$0.50 per mile from Nunda Township Road District office to plant will be added to determine lowest bidder.
- E. The road district will be selecting the three lowest bidders to ensure that there will be no interruption in the supply of asphalt.
